The students through their constant and regular studies have set a new benchmark. The commitment of the management, the constant support of the principal, dedication and hard work of the teachers and students have helped in achieving the excellent result. St. Jude's school expresses its heartfelt gratitude to all of them. Our school has achieved 98.8% result in AISSE class X CBSE Board Exam as a whole and the students have achieved excellent results in their individual subjects as well by their sheer determination, hard work and perseverance. Our school topper is Shambhavi Yewle who scored 95%. Omi Bhawsar who scored 93.7% and Raghavraj Saraf who scored 93.3% are in second and third positions respectively. Out of 163 students, 138 of them have scored first division. The topper of class XII is Murtuza Lokhandwala (Commerce Stream) who scored 93.6%. Isha Gupta (Maths Stream) became second topper scoring 90.2% and Harsh Rana (Biology Stream) became third topper scoring 84%. Out of 52 students, 47 scored first division.
